We will do everything we can to ensure your child develops the understandings, skills and perspectives they need to flourish. We are committed to nurturing your child's growth through personalised ways of learning.



STEM (Science, Technology, **Engineering, Mathematics)**

As part of the Arts program, the specialist subjects of Music, Dance and Drama develops far more than just musical skills. Combined with the instrumental program, School Choir, Festival Choir and School Band, there are many creative learning opportunities available throughout the different year levels.

Early Learning



Playgroup (0-4 years)

Our Playgroup runs in association with SPICE (Supported Playgroups in Catholic Education) and welcomes families with children between the ages of 0 and 4. Playgroup offers weekly sessions in an engaging way for families to participate with their children in learning, socialising and building relationships with other families in the community.

Piccolini (3-4 years)

A weekly Occasional Care Program that provides a seamless transition to Preschool. This program aims to help children develop social and language skills through creative play, preparing your child for Preschool. Available on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Preschool (4-5 years)

Preschool is an important part of St Joseph's Payneham and offers children a supportive environment to learn and develop their Literary, Numeracy and social skills. It also allows children to familiarise themselves in a welcoming space and make new friends. Children who turn 4 years of age by 30th April begin in January.

Mid-year preschool (4-5 years)

This Mid year Preschool Program allows children who are 4 years of age between 1st May and 31st October to learn and develop using the Early Year Learning Framework and the Being, Belonging, Becoming guidelines. This is followed by 18 months in Reception.

Enrolment



Enrolment

- 1. Consider a personal tour when your child is 2-3 years of age. An enrolment calculator for your child is available on the school's website.
- 2. Obtain an Information Package including an Application for Enrolment.
- 3. Lodge an application form and return it to school with relevant documents. A non-refundable Application fee is required which places your child on a waiting list.
- 4. Enrolment will be accepted if the enrolment is in accordance with our Enrolment Policy and available places.
- 5. A letter of Acceptance and Contract is emailed/ posted approximately one year before your child is due to start*. The Enrolment Deposit of \$50 for Preschool and \$100 for School is deducted from first term fees.

*In certain situations, the 'acceptance' time will vary.



At Payneham, we take a personal and progressive approach to your child's learning and wellbeing while planning for future opportunities.

Reception to Year 6 (5-12 years)

With a key focus on self-exploration, Reception to Year 6 is a time for students to explore their individuality. As such, we deliver a stimulating, nurturing environment and challenge all students to attain their highest potential, academically, spiritually, physically, culturally, creatively and socially.

The extensive school curriculum aims to create leadership and social skills which is supported by technology and tools that enhance the learning experience.

We endeavour to provide a balanced, high-quality and personalised curriculum with a strong focus on student wellbeing.
