Dear Parents and Caregivers,

You are warmly invited to the St Joseph's School Payneham Christmas Concert on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> November at 6:30pm. It will be held on the New Oval on Marian Road as a twilight event with food stalls available. You are welcome to bring chairs and picnic blankets for the evening. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, only 2 adults per family may attend this event. We thank you for your understanding regarding these restrictions. Please ensure you check in via the QR Code at the designated entrances (Church Gate, Marian Road and Tarcoma Ave Gate) when you arrive.

Each year level has been given a theme which can be used as inspiration for dressing up. Please note that it is **not necessary to buy costumes for this event.** It is important that students are comfortable and can move easily in their costume. Students have been practising their performances with excitement and effort as a part of their Music curriculum this term, and are all encouraged to attend this festive school event.

The themes and examples of what to wear for each year level are as follows:

#### **Preschool – Reindeers**

Students can wear brown coloured casual clothes with reindeer antlers and some tinsel.



## New Receptions (RC and RJA) – Nativity

Students can dress as angels, shepherds, or the 3 Wise Men. Examples could include wearing an angel halo and white dress/clothes; dressing in loose clothing and putting a scarf over the head; using a tea-towel over the head and a bit of ribbon to secure it; folding an old sheet in half and cutting a hole for the head and using string around the waist to secure it.



#### **Reception A&K – Elves**

Students can wear elf ears/hat with a combination of green and red clothing. An example might be wearing an old green t-shirt and cutting the bottom in to triangles and tying a black belt around the waist.



# **Reception M&NG – Snowmen/women**

Students can wear a white dress or white clothing and cut out three circles using black cardboard to stick on like buttons. You can then add accessories such as a scarf and hat.



#### Year 1 - Candy Canes

Students can wear red and white and could stick candy canes on a piece of long cardboard which they could wear as a crown or belt.



## Year 2 – Christmas Rock Stars

Students can wear items like leather jackets, sunglasses, jeans...whatever they think a "Rockstar" might wear. Then simply add some Christmas "bling" such as a Santa hat, tinsel, etc. (please no props – the photos are just examples)



## Year 3 – Christmas Cowboys/girls

Students can wear items such as jeans, shirts and a bandana around the neck. Add a bit of tinsel or glitter to give the costume a Christmas flair.



# Year 4 – Hollywood/Red Carpet (Christmas Edition)

Students can wear smart clothing (shirt, tie and blazer; nice dress; etc), with something to make it Christmassy (Santa hat, tinsel, Christmas headbands, etc).



## Year 5 – Hawaiian Christmas

Students can wear bright shirts, Hawaiian shirts, thongs and shorts and some tinsel or a Santa hat.



#### Year 6 – Christmas RnB Stars

Students can wear clothing inspired by Hip Hop/RnB/Rap stars with a Christmas "touch" such as tinsel, Christmas hats, etc.



Students are required to be signed in by their class teacher(s) **in their classroom** by no later than 6.15pm. Teachers will then proceed to the stage area with their class. Directly following the conclusion of the concert, parents will be called by year level to collect their child from the designated area on the asphalt. One caregiver is encouraged to sign their child out, to ease congestion. Please ensure that the class teacher has marked your child off before leaving. This is to ensure the safety of all students at the concert.

Staff and students are extremely excited about our upcoming Christmas Concert and look forward to sharing the Christmas Concert with you all.
