

ST JOSEPH'S PAYNEHAM SCHOOL BOARD

The School Board, on behalf of the Parish Faith Community, has the very special responsibility of maintaining and developing St Joseph's Payneham School. It considers areas such as policy direction, financial-management, pastoral care, maintenance and planning.

Permanent School Board members are the Parish Priest (President) and the Principal. In addition, parents may be elected for a two-year term. Parents and Friends and Staff have constant representation through their nominated representatives who also change every two years.

Note – No special qualifications are necessary, just a desire to have a say in the running of your child's school and the will to be involved as a committed parent.

Board meetings are held on the third Wednesday of the month during the school year, and regular attendance is desirable. Moreover, there may be some extra seminars, activities and sub-committees where Board members are expected to participate.

The experience of membership is both rewarding and satisfying, and is one significant way of actively supporting your child(ren) through their Catholic Primary education.

All parents are eligible for nomination, and are encouraged to give this opportunity consideration.
